

Meaningful Use – Modified Stage 2

- All EP's are now subject to the "Modified Stage 2 Rules", even if you're a Stage 1 submitter
- 90 days or LONGER
- 2016 or 2017 – 1st reporting year – 90 days, all others full calendar year
- Newly credentialed doctors – 2 year reprieve from penalties
- 10 objectives – all must be met or excluded
- **Discontinued Criteria: Demographics, Vitals, Smoking Status, Lab Tests, Clinical Summaries, Patient List by Diagnosis, Preventive Care Reminders, Imaging Results, Family History, Progress Reports, Submission to Cancer Registry**

Objective 1: Protect Patient Health Information (Security Risk Analysis)

- Can use tool from ONC
- WWW.HEALTHIT.GOV
- Must be performed in the 1st year (does not have to be during reporting period)
- Must be reviewed each subsequent year

Objective 2: Clinical Decision Support (HCM Rules)

- Measure 1: Implement 5 rules, 4 of which are CQM's
- Measure 2: Yes/No – Enabling and implemented drug-drug and drug-allergy interaction check

Objective 3: Computerized Physician Order Entry

- Stage 1 – >30% of medication orders
- Stage 2
 - >60% of medication orders
 - Exclusion: <100 orders during reporting period
 - >30% of laboratory orders
 - Exclusion: <100 orders during reporting period
 - >30% of radiology orders (OCT, ASCAN, BSCAN, etc)
 - Exclusion: <100 orders during reporting period
 - Orders can only be entered by "licensed healthcare professionals or credentialed medical assistants"
 - CPO, CPOA, COA, COT, COMT

Objective 4: E-Rx

- >50% queried for drug formulary and transmitted electronically
- Exclusion: <100 medication orders during reporting period

- Exclusion: no pharmacies nearby to accept electronic prescriptions at the start of reporting period

Objective 5: Health Information Exchange (Summary of care for Transition of Care)

- Uses Certified EHR to create summary of care and electronically transmit to receiving provider > 10%
- Exclusion: <100 TOC's during the reporting period

Objective 6: Patient Education

- >10% of patients provided with patient specific education resources identified by EHR

Objective 7: Medication Reconciliation

- Performs on >50% of transitions of care from which patient is transferred into EP's care
- Exclusion: Did not receive any TOC's

Objective 8: Patient Electronic Access (VDT)

- Measure 1: Making information available to the patient electronically within 4 days >50%
- Measure 2:
 - 2015/2016
 - At least 1 patient views, downloads, transmits to a third party their health information
 - 2017
 - 5% of patients view, download, transmit to a third party
 - Exclusions: Do not order or create any of the information listed for inclusion except for patient name, providers name, office contact info
 - Exclusion: >50% of patient encounters are in a county that >50% do not have 3Mbps broadband available

Objective 9: Secure Messaging

- 2016: 1 patient must send/respond during the reporting period
- 2017: 5% of patients must send/respond during the reporting period
- Stage 3: >25% of patients must send/respond during reporting period

Objective 10: Public Health Reporting

- Register intent for a public health measure within 60 days of reporting period
- Public Health Measures
 - Ongoing Submission to Immunization Registries
 - Exclusion:
 - EP does not administer immunizations

- EP operates in jurisdiction for which no registry is capable of standards required
- EP operates in jurisdiction for which no registry has declared readiness
- Ongoing Submission to Syndromic Surveillance Data
 - Exclusion:
 - EP does not diagnose or treat any disease or condition associated with or collect relevant data required by specialized registry in their jurisdiction during reporting period
 - EP operates in jurisdiction for which no registry is capable of standards required
 - EP operates in jurisdiction for which no registry has declared readiness
 - Ongoing Submission to a Specialized Registry (For MD's or OD's in a group practice with MD's - IRIS qualifies)
 - Exclusion:
 - EP does not diagnose or treat any disease or condition associated with or collect relevant data required by specialized registry in their jurisdiction during reporting period
 - EP operates in jurisdiction for which no registry is capable of standards required
 - EP operates in jurisdiction for which no registry has declared readiness
- Stage 1 – 1 Measure
- Stage 2 – 2 Measures

CQM's

- 9 from 3 clinical quality domains
- Electronic submission of PQRS counts for CQM's
